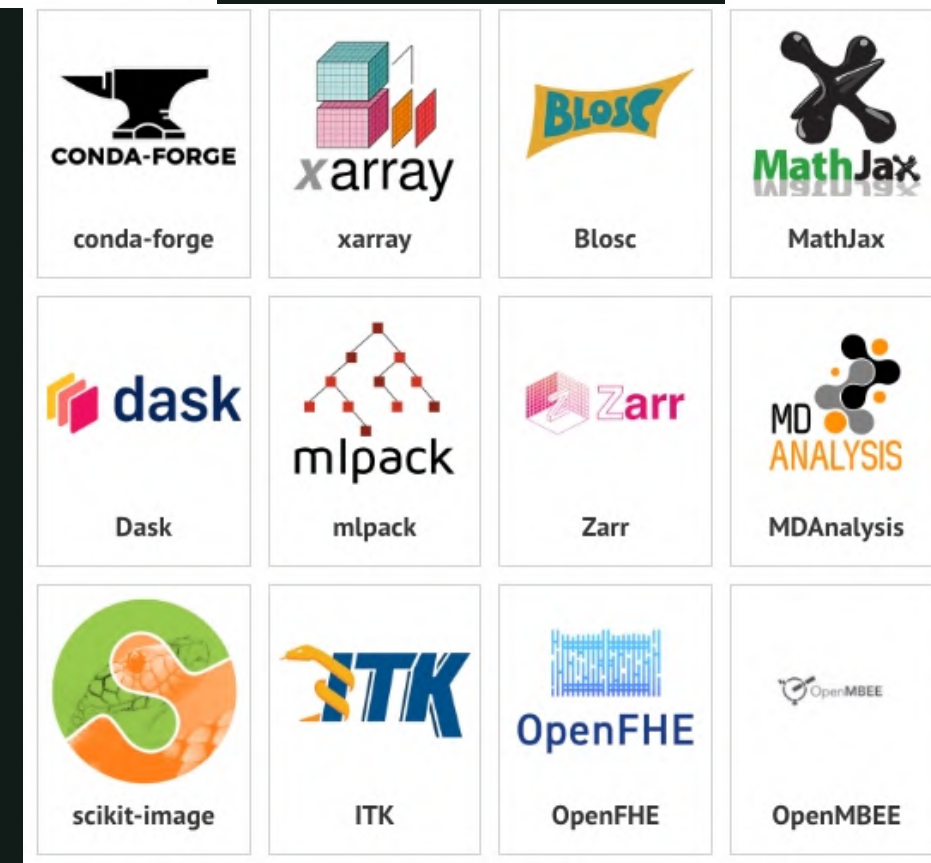
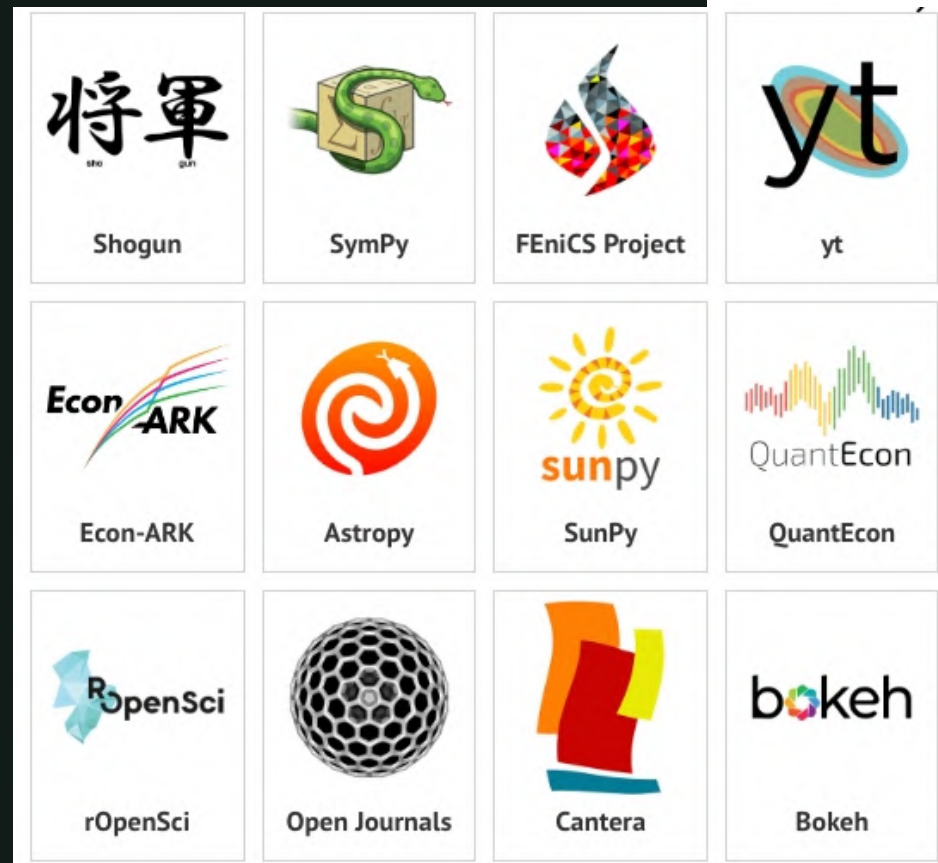
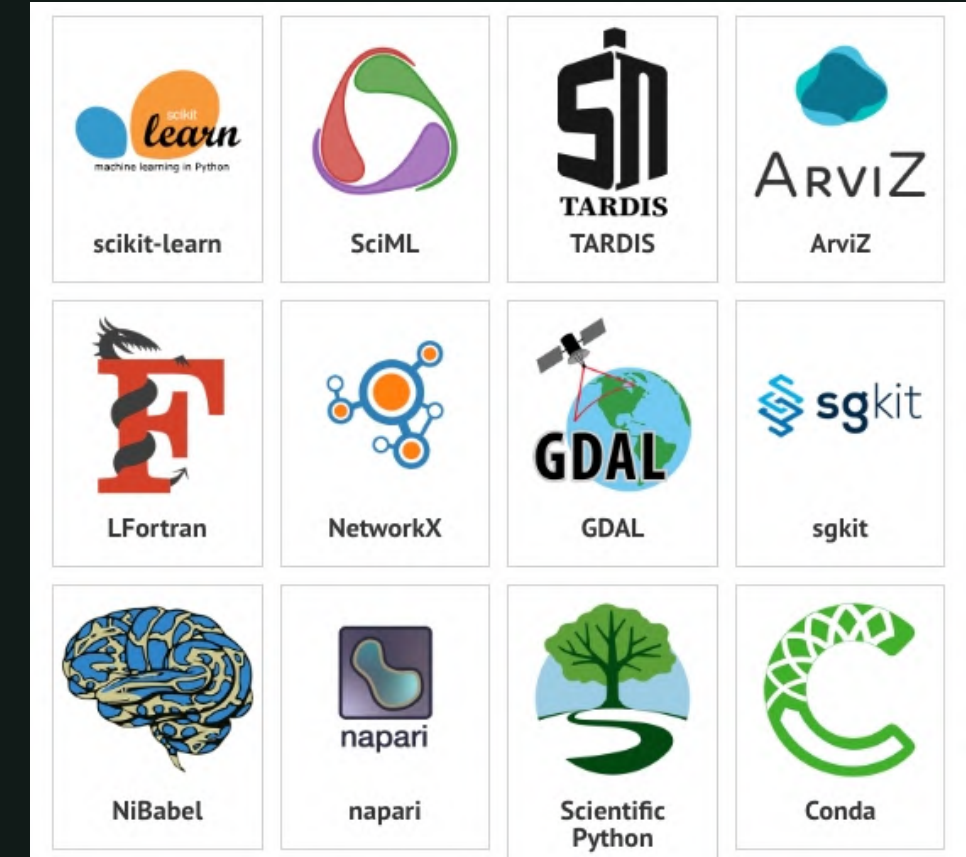

PROJECT CRITERIA

BE OPEN

Open projects typically have:

- Publicly hosted code
- New contributor guidelines
- Open discussion forum(s)
- An OSI-approved license
- A community of active contributors
- A transparent, publicly visible governance model which includes a distributed decision making process
- A roadmap

BE KIND

A healthy, productive, and sustainable community can only be achieved if each project actively works towards making their community friendly, inclusive, and respectful of each participant.

NumFOCUS projects are required to have a Code of Conduct (CoC): a user-facing, public statement on inclusivity and project culture.

BE SCIENTIFIC

NumFOCUS projects contribute to the advancement of scientific research.

This means the project either enables some new research challenges to be addressed, makes addressing research challenges significantly better, or supports a segment of the open science ecosystem.
